Respondent Shri Manish Taneja, Executive Engineer, Manendragarh himself present.

2. He has submitted reply executed before Shri Vijay Prakash Patel, Notary, Manendragarh, Distt. Korea. The reply is taken on record. According to the reply after receiving order of the Electricity Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum, Bilaspur, Jr. Engineer, Baikunthpur prepared a case for refund of security deposit and put it up before Regional Accountant, Ambikapur on 02.07.08. Due to certain shortcomings the case was returned by the Regional Accountant on 11.07.08. The Jr. Engineer was directed to submit the case again after removal of the shortcomings. On resubmission by the Jr. Engineer, the respondent had again sent the case on 02.09.08 to the regional office. The case on approval was sent to the respondent for further action on 29.12.08. On the same day the respondent had prepared cash return form and sent to the Regional Account Officer and the amount was paid to the consumer on 13.01.09.

3. The consumer is exempted from payment of electricity duty from March 2008 in the monthly bills. However, for refund of the electricity duty paid for the period Feb' 2005 to 2008, the case was submitted to the State Government by the CSEB form 4A is required which was not available. The respondent had himself contacted their office in Dec' 08 and obtained form 4A. After completion of the electricity duty refund case it was submitted on 07.02.09 in the office of electricity/safety office, Raigarh and after obtaining permission for adjustment, the respondent has started the adjustment from the bill of Feb'09.

4. On the basis of the reply submitted we find that there is no deliberate disobedience by the respondent of the order of the Electricity Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum, Bilaspur. We, therefore, decide not to proceed with action under section 142 in this case. The case is accordingly closed.
