### Order in order sheet dated 18.06.09

Shri P.Balram Murthy for petitioner and Shri Vijay Singh, CE (Transmission) for the respondent Transmission company.

2. The respondent vide letter No.2117 dtd. 16.6.2009 has informed that the work of construction of 132 KV Bay at 132 KV sub-station, Akaltara has been completed. Further, the petitioner has also completed laying of dedicated 132 KV line from their generating plant to 132 KV sub-station. The line and bay have been charged on 15.6.2009 successfully. Shri P.Balram Murthy representative of the petitioner confirms the position. There is, therefore, no further issue in this case. We would, however, like to observe that this petition arises out of this Commission's order dated 20.3.2008, passed in petition No. 31 of 2007(M). In this case we had permitted short-term open access beyond the period of one year for transmission of electricity from the petitioner's CPP, in relaxation of the open access regulations, pending laying of a 132 KV feeder from the power plant to 132 KV sub-station at Akaltara. Now that this line has been completed, the respondent transmission company shall provide long-term open access to the petitioner and enter into necessary agreement for the same for transmission of power from its CPP to its captive consumer located at Sonadih. The necessary formalities should be completed and the agreement concluded within the period of 15 days from this order. The representative of the Transmission company Shri Singh, CE submits that there should be no problem in concluding the long-term agreement. We would also like to observe, in view of certain instances which have come to our notice that such cases are referred to Distribution company in such cases, that the new feeder is for evacuation of power from the CPP for supply to its captive consumer and that the distribution licensee has no role in it. Therefore, it is not a matter which need to be referred to the Distribution company.

With these observations the case is closed.
